Group Study Questions

1. Read John 14:1-7. How do these verses show that Jesus Christ is the only way to salvation?
2. When you say that Jesus is the only way for salvation, what is the response of most people?
3. If we say that Jesus isn't the only way, what are we saying about Him?
4. Religious pluralism is the belief that all religions have merit and can lead to salvation. Why is that such a popular belief? Read 2 Timothy 4:3.

5. In order to respond to religious pluralism, discuss the following:
 - How are world religions different?

 - In what ways do different religions hold different ethics?

 - In what ways are world religions logically irreconcilable?

6. Discuss reasons why you believe that Jesus Christ is the only way to God.

7. In what ways has your belief in Christ transformed your life?

8. Read 1 Peter 3:15. What does this passage say about the importance of knowing why you believe that Jesus is the only way to God?

9. How does the exclusivity of the Gospel impact the way you share Jesus with others?
