SAMARITAN'S PURSE

Trip Dates and location: Spring and Fall 2022; other trips based on need

Trip Description:

Will serve for one week – arriving on a Saturday evening and departing the site on Friday evening.

Open to adults willing to physically and spiritually impact an area during a stressful recovery time.

Devotions are conducted every morning by staff or volunteers. Immediately following dinner, volunteers will have an opportunity each evening to share their day's experiences with the entire group. After this, the evenings are free.

Costs: Samaritan's Purse covers all lodging and food expenses, provides all the tools, materials and safety gear. The team will divide the cost of a van rental and each person will be responsible for meals during the travel to and from the site.

Samaritan's Purse is a nondenominational evangelical Christian organization providing spiritual and physical aid to hurting people around the world. Since 1970. Samaritan's Purse has helped meet needs of people who are victims of war, poverty, natural disasters, disease, and famine with the purpose of sharing God's love through His Son, Jesus Christ. UGANDA

Trip Dates: January 21st – January 30th

Open to adults only

Trip Application

Complete a Crossroads trip application if a firsttime team member with Crossroads Complete Show Mercy trip application and information

Participate in 2-3 team preparation meetings All team members must complete a background check

Total Cost Approximately \$3000, which includes flights, travel insurance, visa, food, transportation, lodging and projects. Individual is responsible for passport, immunizations, PCR Covid testing in and out of the country (approximately \$50-100 per test) and any personal purchases.

- •\$300 deposit to hold reservation
- •Final payments based on final decision to travel; will work with airlines and Show Mercy for final payment dates.

Trip Description: The majority of your time will revolve around participating in the many ministries and outreaches Show Mercy has already established. All trip participants will have the opportunity to not only focus on what they have a passion for but also join in with new and exciting ministry experiences. Some of the Show Mercy outreaches include but are not limited to:

- Working in the village schools

GUATEMALA

Trip Dates: Feb 12th – 19th, 2022 and June 25th – July 2nd, 2022

Open to individuals and families

Age Requirements for students

- •12-15 years of age traveling with one parent
- •16-18 years of age may travel with an extended family member (grandparent, aunt, uncle) who accepts responsibility for the teen.
- Exception is the Student Mission trip that travels every other year (See S.M. Staff for criteria)
- Team size limited to 30 people

Trip application

- Complete a Crossroads trip application if a firsttime team member
- Must participate in 2-3 team preparation meetings
- All team members complete background check and a Mission Impact application

Total cost - approximately \$2,400 which includes flights, travel insurance, visa, food, transportation, lodging and projects. Individual is responsible for passport, immunizations and any personal purchases of gifts or souvenirs.

- \$300 deposit to hold reservation
- **Mid-Payment** of 1/2 the trip cost due 4 months before the trip. Once this payment is made, you are responsible for the remaining trip balance, unless a substitute can be found.
- Final payment of any remaining fees due 30 days before the trip

• Trip description:

Join us for a week of serving with our global partner, Mission Impact, in Santa Maria de Jesus. Santa Maria is the home village of our coffee farmers for our Coffee House. Our Crossroads family also helps to sponsor many young girls from the village to attend Proximos Pasos – a Christian girls school. Serving opportunities will include projects at the school, school prep activities, health-focused projects such as clean water filters, fuel-efficient stoves and dry-compost latrines. Depending on team size and skill-sets, there can be an opportunity for a remote location project. We will also spend time experiencing the local culture and picking coffee with our head farmer, Julio Cèsar Cuy Xar.

BRAZIL

Trip Dates:

March 19th - 26th, 2022

•Team size limited to 15

Age Requirements for students

- •12-15 years of age traveling with one parent
- •16-18 years of age may travel with an extended family member (grandparent, aunt, uncle) who accepts responsibility for the teen.

Trip Application

- •Complete a Crossroads trip application if a first-time team member
- Must participate in team prep meetings
- •All team members must have a background check Total Cost: approximately \$2800, which includes flights, travel insurance, visa, food, transportation, lodging and projects. Individual is responsible for passport, immunization, PCR Covid testing in and out of the country (approximately \$50-100 per test) and any personal purchases.
- •\$300 deposit to hold reservation
 Final Payment Will give update on total costs as flight prices are determined. Flight purchased once ½ of payment received.

Trip Description:

Partnering with Hope Ministries Brazil, this team will travel by medical boat up the Amazon River to provide some basic medical/dental care to river villages. These are communities will little or no medical access. Hope Ministries has begun relationship with these areas to share the gospel, plant churches and meet physical needs to begin gospel transformation with the people and families in each community. Will travel by boat to serve in river village outreaches along the Amazon. Will also spend time in the city of Castanhal, Brazil with Hope Ministries.



JAPAN

Trip Dates:

May 1st - 9th, 2022

Open to adults only – team size limited to 7 people.

Trip Application:

Complete a Crossroads trip application if a firsttime team member with Crossroads Participate in 2-3 team preparation meetings All team members must complete a background check

Total Cost: approximately \$2500, which includes flights, travel insurance, visa, food, transportation, lodging and projects. Individual is responsible for passport, immunizations, PCR Covid testing in and out of the country (approximately \$50-100 per test) and any personal purchases.

•\$300 deposit to hold reservation

Final Payment - Will give update on total costs as flight prices are determined.

Flight purchased once ½ of payment received.

Trip Description: We will visit PAZ International Coffee House in Kawasaki, where missionaries Josiah and Jennifer Huber serve to reach the young people of Japan through a coffee house ministry. Non-Christian Japanese are very skeptical of churches and most won't set a foot in one. Coffee houses have been on the rise in the last 10 years and this ministry has continued to grow and thrive even through Covid. They hold Sunday services, family groups, discipleship and prayer meetings. They also started Paz Bible College to raise up more church planters and dream of planting coffee house churches all around Japan. The team will learn all about traditional Japanese culture and the barriers they face as they make gospel impact in Japan. There will be an opportunity to participate in a Sunday service and see their outreach during shop hours.



CAMBODIA

Trip Dates: June 2nd – 16th

Open to individuals, families with students age 15-18yrs old (must be accompanied by a parent)
• Team size is limited to 30 people.

Trip application

- Complete a Crossroads trip application if a firsttime team member
- Must participate in 2-3 team preparation meetings
- All team members complete a background check

Total cost: approximately \$3,000, which includes flights, travel insurance, visa, food, transportation, lodging and projects. Individual is responsible for PCR Covid testing, passport, immunizations and any personal purchases of gifts or souvenirs.

- \$300 deposit to hold reservation
- Mid-Payment of 1/2 the trip cost due 4 months before the trip. Your flight ticket will be purchased for you once this payment is received, so you may pay this earlier. Once your ticket is purchased, you are responsible for the remaining trip fees. Flight purchased once ½ of payment received
- **Final payment** Will give update on total costs as flight prices are determine.

Trip Description:

ENGAGE SUFFERING......UNLEASH HOPE Crossroads and Asia's Hope are partnering to care for orphaned children in Cambodia. Imagine for a moment the suffering these children faced before being rescued – hunger, the high potential of being trapped in the sex-slave trade, forced drugrunning, exploitative child labor and early death. Now they have HOPE! Through the generous support of the Crossroads family, the children at the Crossroads of Hope 1 & 2 homes now have loving Christian parents and are receiving an education, medical care and food. They are being raised up in God's love, grace and hope. On these trips, we spend time with the families we sponsor, at the campus school and church, assist in evangelical outreaches in remote villages and on the campus, do a variety of projects or activities on campus and with our homes. We also take time to experience the culture and gain a better understanding of the challenges of being a Christ-follower in a country where there are less than 2 % Christians and centuries of worship to false idols.



GLOBALLEAD

Trip dates: Early August TBD

Open to leaders and teachers of the gospel based on an application/interview process

- Team size based on ministry location and activities
- Complete a Crossroads trip application if a firsttime team member
- Complete an application/interview process with globalLead
- Must participate in 2-3 team preparation meetings
- All team members complete a background check
- Total Cost will be determined by flight prices, travel insurance, visa and on-the-ground fees for the seminar or training. Individual is responsible for passport, immunizations and any personal purchases of gifts or souvenirs.
- Payments will be based on trip timing.

Trip Description:

Trip will be to the Philippines.

globalLead facilitates trainings for youth leaders, pastors and church leadership groups and hosts a seminar called Heart of the Leader, which is designed to encourage, support, prevent burnout and equip pastors and leaders in ways to do self-care as they minister in hard places and situations. Trip participants will assist in prayer, devotionals, perhaps some teaching and encouragement of those indigenous leaders and pastors.

NEPAL

Tentative dates:

September 28th – October 8th

Open to adults only

Team size is limited to 15 people

Trip application

Complete a Crossroads trip application if a first-time team member

- Must participate in 2-3 team preparation meetings
- All team members complete a background check

Total cost - Approximately \$2,500, which includes flights, travel insurance, visa, food, transportation, lodging and projects. Individual is responsible for passport, immunizations and any personal purchases of gifts or souvenirs.

- \$300 deposit to hold reservation
- **Mid-Payment** of 1/2 the trip cost due 4 months before the trip. Your flight ticket will be purchased for you once this payment is received, so you may pay this earlier.
- Final payment of any remaining fees due 30 days before the trip.

Trip Description:

The team will stay the first two nights in some ancient temple areas to receive a tour of the spiritual history and current impact of that, so that then as the teams head out they see directly that they are there to impact the false religious history that is so predominant in Nepal and to proclaim the Good News gospel both verbally and physically. While numbers vary, there are less than 1% Christians in Nepal. The team activities for this trip will be based on the skill-sets of the team and plans developed prior to the trip.

July 2022 - dates TBD

Open to Student Ministry Member and adult leaders.

Applications are available in the fall of the year before the trip. The team meets throughout the year to prepare to serve with a proper attitude of humility, to pray, to serve the local church and community, and to fundraise.

The cost will be approx \$300

We will come together for 6-days at Camp Otyokwah and do service projects, worship gatherings, and discipleship groups daily as we seek to be the hands and feet of Jesus in central Ohio.
